### NAPLAN HIGHLIGHTS

We recently received this year's NAPLAN results. This is only a snapshot of a student's learning and we are happy with where our Lindenow results.

#### **Reading**

87% of Grade 3 and 90% of Grade 5 students achieved at or above the required level.

#### **Writing**

94% of Grade 3 and 89% of Grade 5 students achieved at or above the required level.

#### **Spelling**

75% of Grade 3 and 76% of Grade 5 students achieved at or above the required level.

#### **Grammar & Punctuation**

81% of Grade 3 and 90% of Grade 5 students achieved at or above the required level.

#### **Numeracy**

87% of Grade 3 and 95% of Grade 5 students achieved at or above the required level.
