- how to report image-based abuse (non-consensual sharing of intimate images) to eSafety and when to report to police

Class Music Performances are coming to assembly!

Dear families,

We are excited to share with you that classroom music performances will be coming to Lindenow Assemblies soon. Students from Prep to Year 6 will be sharing with the school what they have been learning in music classes.

For the first few performances we ask that parents and visitors do not attend. The reasoning behind this is to make students feel less anxious about their performance skills and give staff and student leaders time to iron out any bugs that can occur with live instrumental performances.

If your student is performing in a 'Student Audience Only'(see below) performance, please don't worry about missing out on seeing your child. All classes will have the opportunity to perform for 'Open Audience Performance' by the end of the year. We also hope to upload 'Open Audience Performances' on to class dojo for parents that are unable to attend an assembly. It is hoped that the 'Student Audience Only' performance will be the dress rehearsal for an improved performance later in the year.

Year 3- 6 students will all be performing as a class band and students in P-2 will perform various body and instrumental percussion performances. We also hope to have our Fun Singers share their enthusiastic singing talents at an assembly too!

Some extra information about our performances....

Please be mindful that these performances are ran and lead by the students. Students select their song and work as a team to organise that every class member has a band job. Students will be playing all the music live (no backing tracks for Year 3-6 students!) and.... they will be running the amplifiers and audio equipment themselves. So cool, right?!!!

Will our performances sound like the 'real songs', absolutely not!

Will we need to stop and start again, probably!

Will we encounter some really bumpy moments along the way, absolutely!

But what I also know is that every single student has had to dig deep to get where they are for this performance.

And I know that every single student will shine so brightly on our little assembly stage. They really are becoming magnificent musicians!

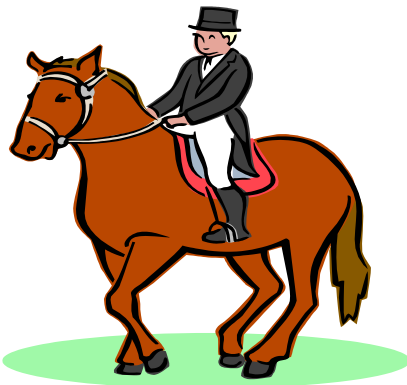
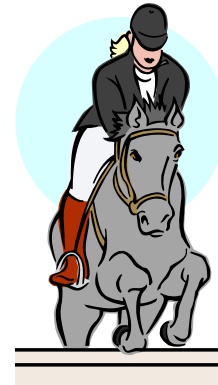
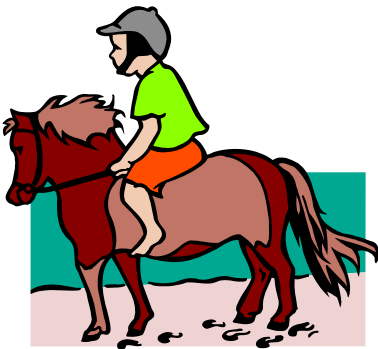
