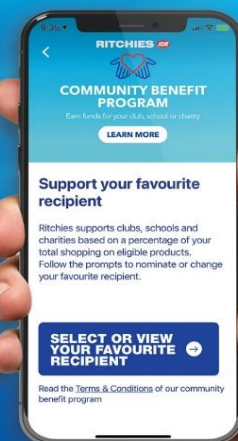

The CFA Needs YOU!

The Country Fire Authority (CFA) is looking for new members to join their East Gippsland brigades. We are specifically interested in recruiting members from the areas of Glenaladale, Flaggy Creek, Hillside, Fernbank, Meerlieu & Bengworden areas as membership in these areas is desperately low.

It's not just about firefighting roles that are up for grabs, non-operational roles are also available.

Firefighting (or operational volunteers) respond to incidents where risks are posed to life and/or property, this may include –

- Responding to wildfires (such as grass fires or bushfires)
- Attending to fires in homes, buildings and sheds
- Attending to road accident rescues
- Assisting with other emergencies, including floods
- Helping with animal rescues
- Attending incidents with hazardous material
- Managing vegetation, such as conducting fuel reduction burns
- Managing fire equipment

Each brigade is different, meaning they will be different in how they respond to incidents. Operational volunteers must:

- Complete General Firefighter (GFF) training before attending incidents, which is a mixture of blended learning
- Be a minimum age of 16 years old or above (16-17 year olds require parental consent)
- Live or work close enough to be able to get to the brigade and the incident in a safe and timely manner. Some brigades allow flexible options such as seasonal or surge volunteering
- Check with your desired brigade directly.

Applicants receive uniform, equipment and training for free.
